



# Summer Arts Camp

For Pre-K and Kindergarten

**Summer Arts Camp** is a full day program that concentrates in the visual and performing arts. Students\* entering Pre-K and Kindergarten are invited to enjoy weekly themed sessions that immerse them in creative discovery through Art, Ceramics, Creative Movement, Dance, Drama, Film and Music. 9:00-2:30 pm with a snack time and a lunch break.

## Star Search

Week #1 (July 6-July 9)

Take an imaginative journey with us to outer space! Learn about the atmosphere, planets, stars and solar system. Does life exist in outer space? Illustrate and design life on another planet. Create your own space alien, design your own spaceship and get ready for blast off!

## Art Around the World!

Week #2 (July 12-July 16)

Take a trip around the world with the Great Neck Arts Center! Students will visit a new country each day. They will learn about various cultures and art history. Passports will be created and stamped each day as we enter a new country.

## Cartoons, Comics & Characters

Week #3 (July 19-July 23)

Learn how to draw your favorite cartoon characters and how to create your own! Students will develop drawing and visualization techniques, storytelling skills and study the creative process of developing cartoons from ink to color and then to the big screen!

Week #4 (July 26-July 30)

Study and discuss the elements of fairy tales, fables and children's stories. Learn about book writing, bookbinding, illustration, and create your own original story to perform for friends.

Week #5 (Aug. 2-Aug. 6)

The Great Neck Arts Center is taking an imaginary trip to the zoo! Learn about different animals and their unique habitats. Study amphibians, birds, fish, mammals and reptiles. Create animal art, learn improvisation skills and perform your favorite animal tales and stories. Don't forget to use your animal instinct!
